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
THE PROCESS OF A PORTRAIT COMMISSION -

It all starts with the photographs. These can be anything from ordinary snapshots to studio shots. The bigger, the better - though a small image will often work well. In general, good photographs yield the best results. Then we discuss the details: Is it a hanging piece or to be installed in a window frame? Are there other size considerations? Is it to be a traditional or contemporary approach? What text would you like to include? Is there a special quotation or a significant date? How many images do you want to include? Then a price and schedule is decided on. Remember, Tom gets booked well in advance, so allow at least 8 weeks for most panels. If you need a rush item, call anyway we'll try to get you in. It may seem like a lot of decisions. Don't worry. His experience and talent will guide you toward a piece you'll love.
